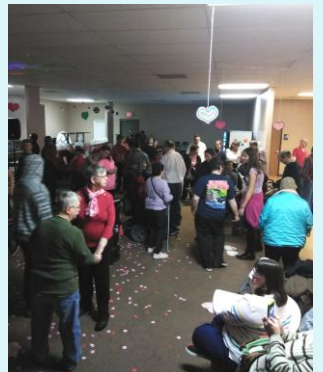

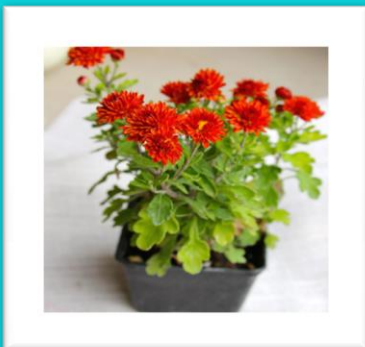

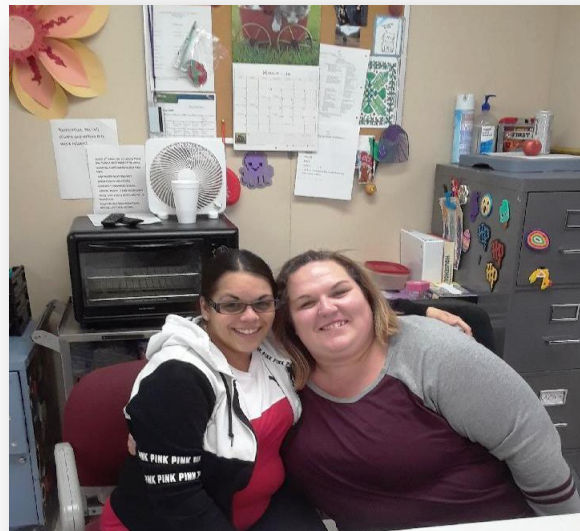


## Getting to Know the Staff in Life Skills
